The petitioners have B.Sc Degree in Agriculture and were working in Agriculture Department as Agricultural Assistants. They have filed W.P(C)No.20111/2005 before the Hon'ble high Court of Kerala and the main contentions raised by them in the W.P.(C) are:

- the cancellation of the existing combined seniority list of Agricultural Assistants for promotion to the post of Agricultural officers which include both non graduates as well as graduates
- Separate seniority list of Agricultural Assistant having graduation in Agriculture
- iii) 3% reservation for thr graduates for promotion as Agricultural Officers out of the 15% presently earmarked for Agricultural Assistants.

2.The Hon'ble High Court in its judgment read as 1^{st} paper above quashed the inpunged Government Order.No. 42835/EA2/04/AD dated 23.2.2005 with a direction to the government to pass fresh orders advertising to the contentions taken by the petitioners with in the time limit specified by the Court.

3.Government have obtained remarks from the Director of Agriculture as per reference read as 3^{rd} paper above and has reported that, for considering the claims of the petitioners, amendment of the existing Government Orders is required which is purely a policy matter of the Government.

4.In compliance of the judgment ,the petitioners were heard by the Agriculture Production Commissioner. The Kerala Public Service Commission was also consulted

5.Government has examined the matter in detail and are pleased to set apart 2% of the posts of Agricultural officers in the 15% quota earmarked for promotion from qualified Agricultural Assistants having B.Sc degree in Agriculture with 3 years service. If qualified candidates are not available in this category such vacancies shall be filled up from among the eligible diploma holders
