

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE DIRECTOR OF AGRICULTURE**

**THIRUVANANTHAPURAM**

Sub:- Establishment – Agriculture Department – Transfer appointment to the post of Agricultural Officer from qualified Agricultural Assistants under 13% quota – Orders issued.

**ORDER No SD (1) 17321/2011, DATED: 16.05.2011.**

As per the standing guidelines, there is 15% quota for the qualified Agricultural Assistants for transfer appointment as Agricultural Officer and Government as per the Government Order read first paper above have apportioned this 15% quota as under:

1. 13% for Agricultural Assistants with pass in suitability test and 10 years service as Agricultural Assistant and
2. 2% for Agricultural Assistants with B.Sc (Agriculture) and three years service as Agricultural Assistant on condition that in the event of non-availability of qualified Agricultural Assistants, the vacancy shall be filled in by the Agricultural Assistants who are Diploma holders.

Forty three vacancies of Agricultural Officers under the category of 13% have arisen consequent on retirement on 31.03.2011. As per the Government Order read as second paper above, Government have approved the Select list containing 19 candidates for the post of Agricultural Officers by transfer appointment from Agricultural Assistants under 13% quota for the year 2011. Sri. V.C. Mathew (Sl. No. 10 in the Select list) has retired on 31.03.2011 on superannuation and as such, the number of Agricultural Assistants to be transfer appointed has come down from 19 to 18.

Under the circumstances, the 18 Agricultural Assistants out of the 19 Agricultural Assistants approved in the select list for the year 2011 are hereby promoted by transfer appointment as Agricultural Officers in the scale of pay of Rs.11070 – 18450 (Pre-revised) and allotted to the Principal Agricultural Officers noted against them for posting in the existing vacancies in the district.

The Controlling officers will relieve them immediately on receipt of posting orders. They will also verify and confirm the qualifications and date of birth of the incumbents with reference to the service books and other original documents.

The Principal Agricultural Officers will report the date of relief and joining of the incumbents along with copy of the RTCs to the undersigned and the Accountant General (A&E), Thiruvananthapuram in due course. The Service Books of the incumbents will be directly forwarded to the Accountant General after updating the entries by the Principal Agricultural Officers for further necessary action.
