Inviting attention to the reference cited, I am to inform you that as per
G.O.(Rt)No.1342/08/AD dated 10.07.2008, Government have revised the ratio of

Agricultural Officers to be posted by transfer appointment as 13:2. 13 for non Graduates and 2 for Graduates in Agricultural B.Sc. The Government Order has only prospective effect. The quota of 2% includes those B.Sc Graduates, who were appointed against 15% quota, prior to the Government Order, dated 10.07.2008.


Since the date of Government Order, 7 Agricultural Assistant having B.Sc were promoted, as such the total number in position is 22 (7+15), 15 promoted earlier in 15% quota) as against the sanctioned number of 24 in 2% quota. Hence the question of reversion does not arise.

There is no vacancy remaining unfilled under 13% set apart for non graduates.
